World Environment Day 2021



Mobius Foundation, in partnership with Gyan Anant Vidyalaya (GAV), commemorated World Environment Day 2021 by raising awareness about the importance of the ecosystems and their restoration.

The two-day event was held on 4th and 5th of June 2021, following are the highlights:

Day 1 event commenced by giving tribute to Indian environmentalist and Chipko movement leader Sunderlal Bahuguna who died on 21st May 2021, due to COVID. He was the man who taught Indians to hug trees to protect the environment. Further GAV students demonstrated their efforts to raise awareness about Environment Day by dressing up as Earth, Dustbin, Water, Tree, Plastic, Newspaper, expressing themselves and spreading the message of being humble and cautious towards Mother Earth. Students created wonderful things from waste materials, sending the message of “**Recycle, Reuse and Reduce**”. Everyone can make a difference by doing simple act, such as saving electricity, planting trees, washing / watering plants using waste water etc. Children enthusiastically participated in the event and involved their parents also to share message effectively with them. Mr. Pradip Burman, Chairperson, Mobius Foundation complimented teachers and students for their performances.



On **day 2** Mobius foundation and Gyan Anant Vidyalaya colleagues exchanged their thoughts and views as to how ecosystem can be restored. Ms. Indira Burman, Vice Chairperson, GAV gave message about protecting environment through a beautiful poem. GAV teachers performed dance, poetry, sanskrit speeches, and other activities related to the theme. The importance of World Environment Day was shared by Dr. Ram Boojh, CEO, Mobius Foundation, Mr. Manoj Karnatak, Ms. Archana,

Ms. Kavya, Ms. Poonam, Ms. Nidhi and Mr. Prabhat. The presentations were given explaining ways to restore the planet through traditional ways of knowledge, awareness to action, turning schools more sustainable, mitigating air pollution etc.


