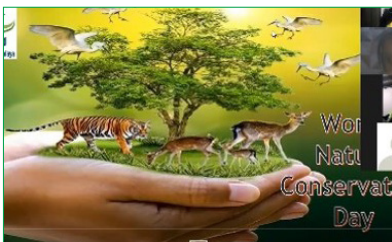

World Nature Conservation Day
July 28, 2021

Observed on July 28 annually, World Nature Conservation Day acknowledges that a healthy environment is the foundation for a stable and healthy society. There is an urgent need for its conservation which means the preservation of forests, land, water bodies etc. Humans have exploited nature for a very long time, which has resulted in extinction of many species.

AAKAR

The selected two hundred villages of Barabanki and Bahraich districts is ongoing distribution of contraceptives, fans, and hygiene kits with support of the frontline workers. The second round of on-ground action has begun and the goal is to expand and reach, primarily in locations where access to family planning services is limited. A wall painting drive in both districts' highways has also been finished in order to raise awareness about family planning.

Mobius Foundation goal is to make resources available to the people who need them. Residents and visitors alike have praised our efforts in response. With the help of National Health Mission (NHM) - UP, our organization is planning to expand this initiative from 2 to 5 districts under AAKAR phase III. We also commemorated World Population Day on 11th July 2021 fortnight by rallying at the village level with the support of Asha workers to raise awareness among the beneficiaries, as well as displaying hoardings and banners.



EMPOWERING TOWARDS CIRCULARITY



ICE & SDGs

The programme has been launched to raise awareness about the relevance of circularity in resource use. A general awareness booklet is being developed about e-waste/plastic waste/Extended producer Responsibility (EPR) principles and policies including circular economy's potential for organizations. The booklet will cover the fundamentals of the circular economy concept, the distinction between zero waste and circular economy, and how it relates to climate change. The booklet will also include case studies around the world to give readers a realistic understanding of how to move towards a circular economy. Under the programme training of online training of trainers will begin in the month of September 2021.

SANJEEVANI PHASE 4

Marking the occasion of Van Mahotsav which is celebrated during 1st week of July every year, Mobius Foundation along with SATHI inaugurated the Phase-IV of Sanjeevani Project on 6th July 2021. This phase will concentrate on “ecosystem restoration” by large-scale plantation with community involvement. The goal is to plant 5000 trees, including Neem, Jamun, Guava, Lemon, Amla, Indian Bel, Banyan etc. Shri. Amit Kaushal, Block Division and Panchayat Officer in Haryana (BDPO) in presence of villagers, ARF and SATHI staff planted the 1st sapling at Chidana village Water House (Jal Ghar).

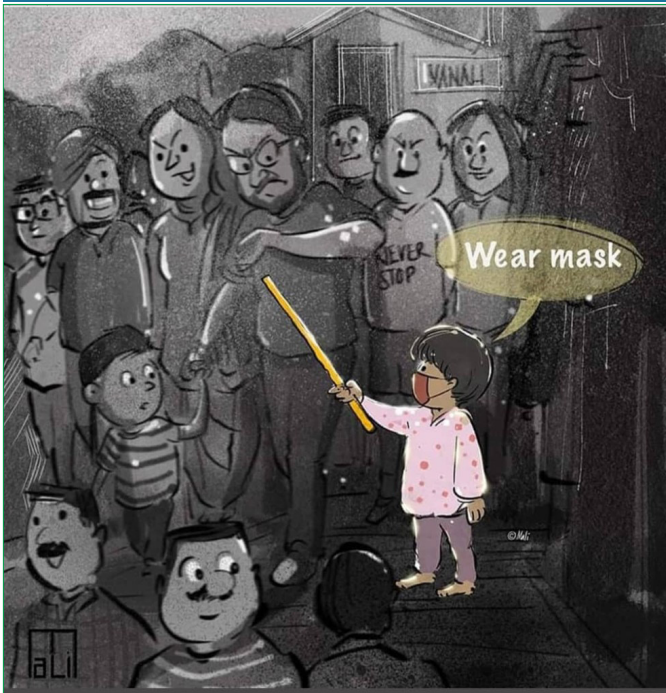

World Population Day

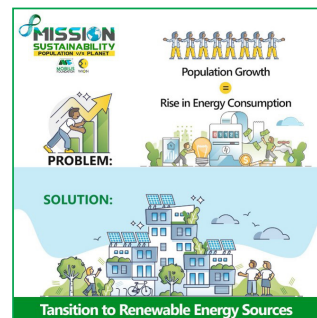
