Training of Trainers on Circular Economy

Foundation along with ICE&SDGs recently conducted a series of 4 training programs, 2 each in the domains of educational institutes and MSMEs. These training programs were conceptualized to capacitate entrepreneurs, academicians, students, professionals for the implementation of the circular economy. A consolidated report of all training programs has been developed, and will soon be uploaded on the MF website. Learning of this program has encouraged to look into the possibilities of other technologies to capture the development being done which have the potential to address the concept of circularity. We are in constant discussion with several experts and will soon come up with a new program in line with foundation's mission to proliferate sustainability education and to provide education for Circular Economy.

The project Aakar is focusing on building awareness and influencing attitude towards Family Planning using various contraceptive measures. From inception of this project, 2 highly populated districts of Uttar Pradesh, Bahraich and Barabanki were in focus.

From this year onwards, the 4 high TFR districts Bahraich, Balrampur, Shravasti, and Siddhartnagar districts of UP, with redesigned strategies based on learnings gained from the previous experiences will be implemented. Preparatory work of identifying high priority blocks of targeted districts has been completed and the program will be launched soon after festival Holi.
