The 4th International Conference on Sustainability Education (ICSE 2022) is being organized on 9th and 10th September 2022 in hybrid mode at SCOPE Complex, Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium Marg, Pragati Vihar, New Delhi by Mobius Foundation in partnership with some of the key environmental organizations. The theme for the conference is 'Building Connections and Partnerships for Sustainable Future' with the aim to provide platform to work together, make connections and strengthen partnerships for a promising tomorrow. As rightly said by Helen Keller, "Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much." Let's stand in global solidarity and collaborate towards a happier, healthier, greener future.

The conference is expected to bring together around 300 participants physically (250 Indians + 50 Foreigners) and will be joined by thousands virtually from across the globe representing multi-disciplinary and diverse group of stakeholders. BIODIVERSITY DAY


