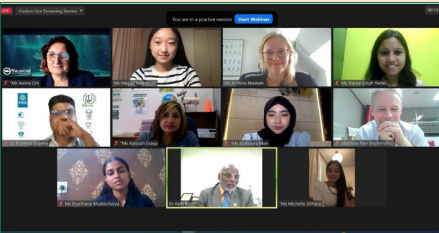
4TH INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON SUSTAINABILITY EDUCATION - ICSE 2022

Advocating the need to bridge the gap between sustainable future and the required actions, ICSE 2022 has been successfully organized keeping in mind the strong urge to create platform both for building interpersonal relationship among learners and educators as well as sharing learnings and experiences aimed towards a sustainable future. The 4th ICSE was held on September 9 and 10, 2022 through **hybrid mode** at SCOPE Convention Centre, New Delhi in partnership with some of the key environmental organizations on the theme “**Building Connections and Partnerships for a Sustainable Future**”. The speakers, dignitaries and delegates joined both physically and



virtually from across the globe representing **multi-disciplinary and diverse group of stakeholders**. We are in the process of developing **special ICSE edition newsletter, recommendation document and ICSE 2022 summary report**. These recommendations will fall under five major thematic areas including **Solutions through Education and Technology, Green Jobs and Circular Economy, Biodiversity and Ecological Restoration, Capacity Building, Climate Literacy and Net Zero Targets**.



As an initiative to offset the carbon emissions of the conference, Mobius Foundation in partnership with **The Climate Project Foundation India & South Asia** and **TERRE Policy Centre** will plant trees at designated areas.

The IV phase of the project was launched on the occasion of **World Population Day, 11th July, 2022**. This phase is covering four high TFR districts of U.P. (Bahraich, Shrawasti, Balrampur and Siddharthnagar).

In Bahraich and Shrawasti, initial data is being collected from identified villages through door-to-door reach. The project has been commenced for more than 54 days and thousands of households have been covered in 28 and 24 villages of both the districts respectively. We are also working to generate Comprehensive Baseline Report. Simultaneously, contraceptives are also being distributed through ASHA workers.

The session was chaired by **Mr Pradip Burman**, Chairman, Mobius Foundation who emphasized on the population stabilization and need of education to save Planet Earth. **Mr William Ryerson**, Founder & President, Population Media Centre stressed that overcoming the barriers of misinformation to people regarding contraceptive services is critically important to change behaviour.

Other eminent speakers of this session were **Ms Andrea Wojnar**, Resident Representative, UNFPA, **Ms Nandita Bajaj**, Executive Director, Population Balance, USA, **Mr Anand Sinha**, Country Advisor, David and Lucile Packard Foundation, and **Dr Poonam Muttreja**, Executive Director, Population Foundation of India who discussed on the issues of over- population, family planning, women empowerment and shared their works and experiences related to this concern.

The day was immensely enjoyed by the students as well as the teaching fraternity.



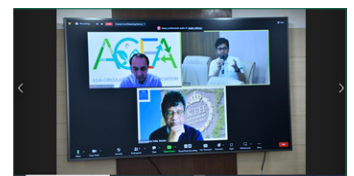
CIRCULAR ECONOMY

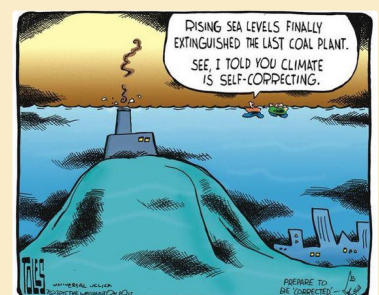
DIGITAL CAMPAIGN
