Project Aakar is now showing **positive signs** of its acceptance by men and women alike adopting family planning practices. However, **more women** are coming forward for permanent sterilisation than men. Mobius Foundation is organizing regular **health camps** where locals get free health check-up and **counselling services** like blood pressure, diabetes as well as telemedicine consultations to promote more acceptance of family planning practices in both the districts. During the month of **December 2022**, around 181 candidates from both districts were benefitted from these camps. As part of the NHM programme, every 21st of the month, **Khushal Pariwar Diwas** is observed which serves as an important point of spreading family planning related awareness, counselling, motivation and mobilisation.
