

International Conference on SUSTAINABILITY EDUCATION (ICSE)

A conference of great minds of the world discussing on a common goal is a valuable asset and pioneering step towards a desired change. With the ambition to promote sustainability education and build necessary alliances and networks, the 4th ICSE 2022 was successfully organized on **September 9 and 10, 2022** through **hybrid mode** at **SCOPE Convention Centre, New Delhi, India** in partnership with some of the key environment and sustainability organizations on the theme **Building Connections and Partnerships for a Sustainable Future**. The conference provided platform for building collaborations, both for interpersonal relationship among learners and educators as well as for sharing learnings and experiences on Education for Sustainable Development (ESD).

The journey of ICSE 2022 started with a pre-conference **Youth Conclave** on 8th September 2022 where hundreds of young people from all over the world joined virtually to share their climate action projects and initiatives. The two days **main event** brought together more than **400 delegates** belonging to **multi-disciplinary and diverse group of**



stakeholders in person as well as via zoom. The entire conference and technical session broadcasts received **more than 40,000 views on social media platforms** which are still counting. The conference had 5 plenaries, 17 parallel thematic sessions and a specific session for **paper and poster presentations** contributed by experts and young professionals. There were also variety of **exhibits** showcasing the works related to environment of partners and other organizations. Post-conference, a **nature trail** to Sunder Nursery was organized on 11th September 2022 for everyone to experience the bounties of nature.

Taking a step further in this process of transformation through sustainability education, the **5th version of ICSE** is being planned on 9th and 10th September 2023 at India Habitat Centre on the theme **Educating for Climate Action and Sustainability** focussing on the urgent need to take actions through strengthening climate education at all levels. ICSE 2023 will focus on education for climate action through various panels, thematic tracks/ sessions, workshops and related deliberations.






AAKAR

The fourth phase of the project Aakar was launched on World Population Day, 11th July 2022. It aimed to spread awareness about responsible reproductive behaviour and to facilitate shaping family size through counselling, contraceptive distribution and the right medical assistance for family planning. Currently, the foundation is active in **two high total fertility rate (TFR) districts (Bhariaich and Shravasti)** of Uttar Pradesh. For each district, MF in close coordination with each district health office has identified **two blocks**, each with **25 villages**. Some of the **major activities** of this project are door-to-door awareness campaigns, distribution of information, education, and communication (IEC) materials, counselling of males/females of reproductive age groups, monthly celebration of khushal parivar diwas, facilitation of diabetes, blood pressure check-up and doctor's consultancy through telemedicine mode. MF also supplements the **NHM program "NSV Pakhwara"**, which aims to increase the participation of men in the decision-making process related to family planning. Over the course of four months, the MF team counselled and mobilised **100 females** of reproductive age to undergo **permanent sterilization (tubectomy)**. In addressing the need for breaking down barriers and bringing men into family planning decisions, our male-focused awareness and counselling activities have yielded some encouraging results as **eight eligible males** have undergone **No Scalpel vasectomy (NSV)**. Among the major challenges our team faces on the ground is opposition from minority communities because of religious sentiments and taboos.



VIRAM: AGENDA SUSTAINABILITY

Mobius Foundation and India Today Group unveiled “VIRAM: Agenda Sustainability” on 23rd November 2022, a year-long campaign to highlight the impact of rising population on environment and sustainability. The launch event was organized as Thought Leadership Conclave having two sessions of panel discussions each in English for India Today and in Hindi for Aaj Tak. The panellists were eminent academicians, policy professionals, and researchers from the fields of demography and policy. The programme began with a fireside chat between the host, Ms. Akshita Nandagopal, Anchor, India Today, and Mr. Pradip Burman, Chairman, Mobius Foundation. It was followed by the panel discussions: ‘**Overpopulation: Everything Connects**’ moderated by **Ms Akshita Nandagopal** and ‘**बढ़ती आबादी, घटते संसाधन: सतत विकास की चुनौती**’ hosted by **Mr. Sayeed Ansari**.

Speaking as the guest of honour, **Mr Zakir Khan** humorously and wisely addressed the issue of over-population.

The event was a great success and the launched episodes were aired on India Today television on 17th December 2022 at 7:30 pm - 8:00 pm and the following day, on Aaj tak channel dated 18th December 2022 from 2:00 - 2:30 pm. A total of 12 episodes will be telecasted on both the news channels each in a year's time.





GYAN ANANT VIDYALAYA (GAV)

GAV organized a **workshop on climate change** on 3rd December 2022 and was attended by G principal, teachers and all other staff members. Chief guest **Ms. Rekha Lalla**, The Climate Project Foundation India & South Asia, a teacher trainer, author, TEDx speaker, and CII Certified Expert on Climate Change & Sustainability made everyone understand the need of climate emergency that demands action from all of us in contemporary times. GAVians, being a school based on SDG, pledged to play a vital role in this field. Teams of teachers were assigned to seven major groups of Air, Water, Energy, Waste, Biodiversity, Climate Innovation, and Community Outreach for projects in which they will be working with the students on Air quality index, Water preservation and conservation, Energy conservation, Waste management, Biodiversity support, Innovative ideas and measures to stop and reverse climatic change and how to reach the community to spread the mission.



STUDY VISIT TO GOVARDHAN ECO VILLAGE (GEV) AND RALEGAN SIDDHI

A team from Mobius Foundation (MF) visited Govardhan Eco Village (GEV) and Ralegan Siddhi during last week of October and November 2022 respectively.

The team witnessed **GEV, a sustainable village model** that demonstrates alternative sustainable model of the world based upon values striking harmony with self, nature and humanity; combining contemporary sustainability technological interventions with powerful optimized scalable action models. GEV team has implemented various initiatives including Waste Management System, Soil Biotechnology Plant, Rain Water Harvesting System, Plastic Pyrolysis Plant, Green Building Structure and many more. MF team also met **Mr. Gauranga Das**, Director, GEV and discussed the vision behind the model eco village along with the possible future prospects.



Ralegan Siddhi, considered as a **model of environmental conservation**, has carried out programs like tree planting, terracing to reduce soil erosion and digging canals to retain rainwater. For energy, the village uses solar power, biogas and windmill. Indian social activist **Anna Hazare**, leader of the village, is recognised for his contributions to the development of the village. He was awarded the Padma Bhushan-the third-highest civilian award by the Government of India in 1992 for his efforts in establishing this model village. The team was honoured to meet him.

Special Days





Climate Change – the fact (2019), a documentary presented by David Attenborough that discusses climate change and possible solutions to counteract it.
