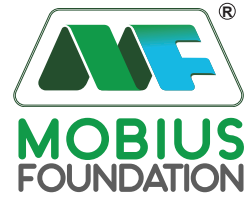


# MARCH DIARY

## ICSE 2023

### Dates for ICSE 2023 CHANGED!

International Conference on Sustainability Conference (ICSE) is a flagship event of Mobius Foundation which brings eminent speakers and hundreds of delegates from various parts of globe on one platform to participate in inter-generational, inter-cultural, interdisciplinary conversations on the environmental topics of global community and interest. It is organized as a two-day main event dedicated to environment from having dialogues, panel discussions, stalls, exhibitions, workshops to paper and poster presentations and much more, on the much-needed and concerning hotspots in the field of environment and sustainability whilst connecting them to the need of sustainability education.



The **Technical and Advisory Committee (TAC)** meeting is conducted to discuss the specifics of ICSE. On 9<sup>th</sup> February 2023, the 14<sup>th</sup> TAC meeting was held ICSE 2023 and various important decisions were taken to kick-start the preparatory process of the conference. These include finalizing the conference format, dates, tentative number of participants, side events and much-more.

Although ICSE is organized on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> September every year, however, the dates have been shifted to 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> September 2023 due to clashing dates with G20 Leader's Summit. The venue has been decided to be India Habitat Centre, New Delhi.

Discussions with TERI, Climate Reality Project-India and South Asia, TIMES Network, Pushpa Gujral Science Centre, Kalinga University, TERRE Policy Centre were held for their support, partnership and collaboration in ICSE.

### Supplementing the Government's Family Planning Program



Aavahan Mela, was organized to recognize the contributions of ASHA workers towards promoting Family Planning in their respective villages, has been successfully concluded in Shravasti and Bahraich on 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 and 15<sup>th</sup> February, 2023 respectively under Project Aakar. It was graced by distinguished government officials such as the District Magistrate, Chief Development Officer, and Chief Medical Officer in both the districts. They appreciated the work done by MF team.

The baseline report of Project Aakar has been prepared. The report highlights various issues, such as gender biases and distribution mechanisms for contraceptives, which require improvement. This report will serve as a foundation for designing specific interventions aimed at generating greater awareness and promoting changes in family planning behaviours. The interventions will be targeted to achieve more profound impacts in the desired areas.
