MOBIUS YOUNG CLIMATE LEADERS PROGRAMME



The Mobius Young Climate Leaders for Himalayan Development Project, led by the Climate Studies & Knowledge Solutions Centre and Government of Nagaland, has achieved noteworthy advancements in the last sixth months. YouthNet is executing the project, which centers around three primary components. The successful integration of the pani-pahar curriculum from the University of Cambridge is underway in 15 schools, promoting tangible climate actions such as Mobius Green Friday. The “research and development” aspect, with a focus on translating indigenous knowledge, has concluded its initial data collection phase. Furthermore, collaboration with the Nagaland Bee Keeping and Honey



Mission is contributing to a strategic plan for advancing the honey sector, aligning with sustainable development goals in Nagaland.

GYAN KANYA SHAKTI: 100 SCHOOL PROGRAMME

Under Gyan Kanya Shakti, health and hygiene check-up was organized for students at four Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) in Chitrakoot, Uttar Pradesh. A dedicated medical team from the Government department conducted thorough check-ups, including measurements of Body Mass Index (BMI) and haemoglobin levels. This comprehensive health assessment aimed to address the well-being of the girls residing in KGBVs. An awareness session was also conducted to educate the girls on maintaining good menstrual hygiene practices. In addition to health initiatives, MF facilitated the distribution of essential school supplies such as notebooks and registers to the girls.

Similarly, in Madhya Pradesh, Mobius Foundation in partnership with Birla Hospital, Satna and Sadguru Netra Chikitsalaya, Chitrakoot, organized a health check-up and awareness camp at Shasakiye Kanya Madhyamik Vidyalaya, Unchehra. Nearly 150 girls were screened for their overall health and optical health, in this two-day camp.

Project Ummeed: A total of **631 new Family Planning clients** were mobilised by the project. The preferred methods of contraception were **Antara (24%), Chaya (44%) and Mala N (20%)**.

Swasthya Mela organised on 28th Nov, 2023, in Gram Panchayat Tappe Sipah, Jarwal Bahraich. 34 Asha, ANM and CHO provided family planning services to 200 adolescent and 300+ women/men. The mela was inaugurated by ADO Panchayat and ABSA.
