DIVING DEEP WITH DOLPHINS: THE URGENCY OF CONSERVING ENDANGERED SPECIES

The Mobius Foundation, in partnership with the Central Bank of India, organized an event on October 13th, 2023, in New Delhi, to raise awareness about dolphin conservation and find innovative solutions. The event, took place at Bikaner House, where **Mr. Pradip Burman**, Chairman, Mobius Foundation and **Mr. Praveen Garg**, President, Mobius Foundation highlighted the importance of river dolphins, the





role individuals can play in their conservation and how Mobius Foundation is working towards creating awareness on the need for strengthening their conservation efforts. The panel discussion was moderated by **Ms. Gargi Rawat**, News Anchor, NDTV. The experts – **Mr. G. Ashok Kumar**, Director General, National Mission for Clean Ganga (NMCG), Ministry of Jal Shakti, **Mr. Sanjay Upadhyay**, Supreme Court, Advocate, Founder and Manging Partner of India's First Environmental Law Firm, Enviro Legal Defence Firm, **Dr. Sandeep Behera**, Consultant, NMCG and **Mr. Suresh Babu SV**, Director, River basins and Water Policy, WWF, discussed the several pressing issues related to riverine dolphins in India. The panel discussion was interactive, with a Q&A session with the audience.

Uttar Pradesh: Mobius Foundation impactful journey in Chitrakoot reached new milestones during the past quarter. In addition to the regular interactive classes under FLN, Mobius Foundation's Gyan Kanya Shakti initiative witnessed a series of significant events that enhanced its commitment to the holistic development of the girls in four Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs).

One major addition to the activities was inauguration of interactive classes by Mr. Abhishek Anand, District Magistrate, UP with inclusion of an eye checkup camp. During the inauguration, Mr. Anand emphasised the importance of visual health in the girls' overall well-being along with quality education. A thorough health assessment, including BMI measurements and haemoglobin level checks, was also conducted benefiting 400 girls. This quarter's activities not only identified health concerns but also provided necessary medications. Further recognizing the importance of environmental sustainability, Mobius Foundation also took a step towards promoting eco-friendly practices. Biodegradable sanitary pads were distributed, aligning with our commitment to a healthier planet and promoting proper Menstrual Health Management (MHM).

Madhya Pradesh: The quarter commenced on a positive note with the distribution of notebooks to more than 350 students at GGMS in Unchehra, Satna, and KSP in Karhal, Sheopur, ensuring a conducive learning environment. The Gyaan Kanya Shakti (GKS) team brought to notice of Collector, Satna, the deplorable condition of toilets at

Unchehra school and hostel. He took cognizance and allocated funds to make necessary repair works. The GKS team also installed a sanitary pad vending machine and incinerator, promoting menstrual hygiene. A two-day health check-up camp was also organized by Mobius Foundation at Govt. Girls Middle School in Unchehra, Satna, involving blood tests, consultation with gynecologist, dietician and ophthalmologist along with an interactive session with the infection control officer. The camp successfully covered over 150 girls, contributing to the holistic well-being of the students. This quarter demonstrates Gyaan Kanya Shakti's dedication to education, health, and empowerment, positively impacting the lives of students in these areas.



The vacant rooftops can be utilized for rooftop gardening. It will enhance Delhi's green cover and biodiversity. The rooftop gardening does not require mush soil and chemicals. Citizen can grow vegetables like spinach, cucurbits, coriander, fenugreek and fruits like papaya. The rooftop garden has the potential to decrease the temp by

Thawing Glaciers

The article highlights the critical environmental challenges faced by the people of Lahaul and Spiti (Himachal Pradesh), situated in the Hindu Kush-Himalayan region, known as 'The Third Pole.' Rapid climate change-induced alterations in the cryosphere, particularly the accelerated retreat of glaciers pose imminent threats to water security in the region. The repercussions include dwindling water resources, drying irrigation channels, and severe water shortages impacting agriculture and other activities. Additionally, the melting glaciers give rise to hazards like glacial lake outburst floods (GLOF). Urgent adaptation measures, such as solar-powered river lift irrigation and

artificial glaciers, are crucial for ensuring a sustainable future amid escalating climate change impacts.


Breaking Boundaries starring David Attenborough and scientist Johan Rockstrom examine Earth's biodiversity collapse and how this crisis can still be averted.
