A total of 133 girls were screened, out of which 2 girls were referred for ultrasound and 1 girl to the neurologist at the district hospital. Depending on the diagnosis, students were given allopathic as well as homeopathic medications. The students were also counselled against using teeth cleaning powder, which leads to permanent teeth damage.

Comprehensive Initiatives for Social Change: Tackling Child Marriage and Promoting Reproductive Health

उम्मीद The Age at Marriage Campaign, “Ek Yudh Bal Vivah Ke Viruddh,” was launched in Bahraich by District Magistrate Ms. Monika Rani, targeting child marriage with the tagline “Itni bhi kya jaldi hai?” The initiative, developed by the Population Foundation of India, includes posters, stickers, and placards. The launch event involved a pledge to eradicate child marriage, with Chief Medical Officer Dr. Satish Kumar Singh leading the commitment. The campaign materials will be distributed to convergence departments. A media workshop chaired by Dr. Singh highlighted the adverse effects of child marriage on maternal and infant health.

MF achieved significant milestones in promoting permanent sterilization techniques, garnering recognition through Certificates of Appreciation and Shields. The team conducted repetitive counselling sessions targeting various groups, emphasizing female sterilization, Non-Scalpel Vasectomy (NSV), and the Antara injection. Collaborative efforts with Gram Pradhans and Asha Didis facilitated widespread community engagement. Counselling sessions camps proved instrumental, with 4 males opting for NSV and over 15 females choosing tubectomy.
