



In many corners of rural India, the spark of education in a girl's life is often dimmed too early. Traditional norms, economic hardship, and systemic neglect make it difficult for girls to stay in school—let alone thrive. Gyan Kanya Shakti (GKS) was born to rewrite this reality.

Initially conceived as a plan for 100 feeder schools, GKS evolved into a more sustainable and impactful initiative strengthening existing government-run girls' residential schools, known as **Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs)**. These schools became the fertile ground where potential could flourish.

What makes GKS unique is its **360-degree approach**. From academics to emotional resilience, from digital learning to menstrual hygiene—GKS touches every part of a girl's life. It empowers not only the girl but the ecosystem around her families, communities, and institutions.



Why Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya?

GKS program in Uttar Pradesh

The Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya (KGBV) scheme, launched in 2004 by the Government of India, aims to ensure access to quality education for girls from disadvantaged communities primarily SC, ST, OBC, and minority groups through residential schools at the upper primary level. The scheme focuses on Educationally Backward Blocks (EBBs) and reserves 75% of seats for marginalized girls, with 25% for girls from below poverty line families.

Aligned with the vision of Gyan Kanya Shakti (GKS), KGBVs address critical gaps in girls' education by offering a safe, inclusive, and empowering residential learning environment. Both initiatives share the goal of enabling adolescent girls to break cycles of exclusion through education, especially in underserved regions of Bundelkhand like Chitrakoot, Mahoba, Banda, Hamirpur & Kaushambi of Uttar Pradesh, where GKS is actively working.



Our Approach


The GKS initiative begins with securing permissions from key authorities: the District Magistrate, Education Department, and Health Department. These permissions are crucial for the program's implementation, ensuring coordination and support from relevant governmental bodies. By obtaining approval from these entities, GKS can effectively proceed with its mission to empower girls through knowledge acquisition and holistic development.

Our Intervention

- Smart Class-based Education: Equipped with audiovisual tools, our smart classrooms focus on
 Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FNL) with
 implementing partner Lotus Petal Foundation,
 addressing the specific learning needs of girls in
 grades 6 to 8.
- Health and Sanitation: We organize health camps and awareness sessions to ensure girls have access to essential healthcare services.
- Life Skills and Vocational Training: Our curriculum includes soft skills, vocational training, and personality development, empowering girls to thrive in their communities and the job market.



- Time to time medication and treatment if required.
- Spectacles for girls with vision issues.
- Vaccination drive for students in collaboration with health department.
- Awareness Camps based upon the requirement (MHM, Dental, self defenseetc)
- Parent counselling, timely PTM & SMCs Use of contemporary pedagogy to foster high degree of engagement.





Implementation

The Gyan Kanya Shakti (GKS) initiative, led by Mobius Foundation in partnership with Lotus Petal Foundation, made significant strides across 17 Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) in five districts of Uttar Pradesh Chitrakoot, Mahoba, Hamirpur, Banda, and Kaushambi targeting education, health, and empowerment of adolescent girls.

Strategic Government Partnerships:

MoUs signed with 12 districts under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan for expansion in more schools.

SCERT UP approved FLN and Life Skills curriculum, validating academic quality.

Regular project updates and presentations shared by Ms. Poonam Parihar at SSA Lucknow to align efforts and drive support.

Education Interventions:

Interactive online classes launched in 17 schools for Class 6 students.

IT setup completed in 13 schools; issues resolved swiftly by MF coordinators.

English workbooks & learning materials distributed;

AQA (Academic Quality Assessment) to assess the knowledge and skills of students involved in evaluating the quality of learning the students have received through the Academic Program

Libraries set up in all 17 schools with support from Ratna Foundation.

Health & Hygiene:

Health & eye camps conducted across all schools:

25% girls anaemic, 43% underweight, 138 received spectacles.

Sanitary pad distribution and MHM sessions promoted menstrual health.

Regular BMI and hemoglobin assessments supported early interventions.

Holistic Development:

Life Skills Education (LSE) sessions conducted with regular evaluations.

Education Week celebrated with thematic days FLN, TLM, Skilling, Sports, Culture, Nutrition, and Eco Awareness.

Festival celebrations (Independence Day, Janmashtami, Holi, Women's Day) enhanced cultural connection and motivation.

Community & Environment:

Plantation drives and eco-awareness activities conducted in 8 schools.

Sports kits and Go Green T-shirts distributed to encourage health and sustainability.

PTMs held across all schools with 35% parental participation; efforts ongoing to increase engagement.

Responsive Implementation:


Regular field visits and assessments help identify needs at the "nook and corner" level be it academic, health, emotional, or infrastructural.

Dedicated resource persons placed in all schools to ensure smooth execution and support.

Anjana Devi, an 11-year-old student from Kasturba Gandhi Balika Awasiya Vidyalaya, Manjhanpur, faced many challenges in her education. Due to financial struggles and family issues, she had to drop out after Grade 2. She was Re-enrolled in Grade 6th after 3 years of gap, where she was not even able to recognize.

Enrolled in Gyan Kanya Shakti Program by Mobius Foundation with academic support from Lotus Petal Foundation. Benefited from interactive online classes in English, Math, and Science. Now able to read & write sentences, perform arithmetic, and has developed an interest in science.



Aarti, a bright and ambitious student form Kasturba Gandhi Residential Girls' School. Despite being a brilliant student, Aarti faced challenges. constant headaches and watery eyes made learning difficult.

She was given glasses, eye drops and vitamin A supplements. And the changed everything. This time her eyesight was stable and she was guite confident.



Nancy, a student of Grade 6th was found to have extremely low haemoglobin levels and was underweight. The warden was immediately informed, and the doctor prescribed iron supplements and a diet chart. A follow-up health check was scheduled after one month. This proactive intervention ensured timely attention and better care for the students. This initiative showcases how targeted healthcare interventions can drive positive change at the grassroots level.
